

South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District Permit Application



Businesses that handle or store hazardous substances in excess of 220 pounds or have infiltration systems which manage stormwater from parking lots or other industrial surfaces (by means of a slot drain, drywell, detention pond, etc.) are required to get a South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District (STGPD) operating permit [Tacoma Municipal Code – Chapter 13.06.070.D].

Each facility required to get an STGPD operating permit must provide an inventory of all hazardous substances used or generated and demonstrate compliance with hazardous substance management practices. This includes applicable standards of Underground and Aboveground Storage Tanks (UST/AST), and the submission of use and maintenance records for any infiltration systems on site.

VALIDATION

We will perform an initial inspection once we receive the application/facility information sheet. We will perform biennial inspections in subsequent years.
